The Backstage View: A Mundane History of Collecting

After more than half a century of intense scientific exploration, resulting in hundreds of in-depth studies, the history of collections has established itself as one of the privileged fields of research in humanities. Various issues such as the provenance of objects in collections; ways in which these objects have been ordered, arranged, and displayed; rooms and buildings in which they have been kept and exhibited; narratives beyond objects and collections; biographies of collectors; social practices connected with collections, etc. have been versatiley investigated. This conference aims to explore the various aspects regarding the mundane site of the history of collecting. We intend to question the multitude of logistic, administrative, organisational, and managerial practices that contribute to the act of collecting and how they affect selling and buying artwork. We are interested in identifying and studying the elements that mark out the diverse and versatile collecting apparatuses in specific cultural, social, and economic realities, both private and public. Changes in issues, paradigms, and availability are at the heart of our study.

Artistic Practices in Educational Contexts (Berlin, 23–24 Jun 23)

Art thinking doing Art. Artistic Practices in Educational Contexts From 1900 to Today. There is a kind of authoritarian conception of what art is and how it is made and communicated as a practice that overlooks the ways in which forms of knowledge and production of art that deviate from this have been developed in non-authoritarian, resistant or anarchist contexts. In order to counter traditional, academic art pedagogical forms of teaching that are fraught with power structures, we want to look at alternative forms of teaching.

The aim is to demonstrate within art history how the place where artists are trained has an impact on the forms and meanings they produce. Historical case studies and contemporary examples will be used to formulate an art historical narrative at the intersection of practice knowledge and art practice. We are particularly interested in contributions that address lesser-known and marginalized models outside of Europe and the United States.

Following the late-1986 opening of the Musée d'Orsay, 19th-century sculpture has progressively freed itself from its previous prolific and academic image that saw it described as 'boring' by none other than Baudelaire.

Histoire publique et bande dessinée : actualité et potentialités des écritures et des usages de l'histoire en bande dessinée - Cycle de journées d'études 2023-2025.

QC - Critical views on Latin American comic strips

The Cultural Secretariat of the IILA - International Italo-Latin American Organisation, opens the call for participation in the 5th issue of the journal "Quaderni Culturali IILA" - 2023.

Latin American comic strips, as an object of study, had a slow entry into foreign universities and even more so in Latin American ones, undervaluing their cultural impact and the potential of their language. However, in recent years, this has begun to be reversed through the organisation of congresses and seminars, the emergence of specialised groups and journals, as well as the creation of chairs dedicated to their study. In these instances, the establishment and expansion of the canon has been discussed, as well as the status of the comic strip in the academic sphere, taking into account the tensions that arise when approaching it critically.

For this reason, the new issue of the journal "Quaderni Culturali IILA" will aim to focus on Latin American comic strips, considering their various artistic, cultural and political manifestations.
