1950-2020: Active Women in the Art Market

Mapping Gallerists, Collectors, Maecenas, Auctioneers, Curators from Iberian Peninsula and Brazil and their contributions to the Global Art System

October 11-12

The aim of this Autumn Colloquium is to shed light on women that during their lives have distinguished themselves as intermediaries in the art markets. Gallerists, collectors, Maecenas, auctioneers, and curators have been building a work culturally engaging, in many circumstances socially invisible, that until recently had not yet received much attention in comparison with their male peers. It is a purpose to revert and to make more visible the work of active women that contributed to the birth of the infrastructures of the art market, internationalizing artists, supporting exhibitions, collecting commissioning, and curating.

The timeframe is from 1950 onward, the period where that role is clearly noted. With a geographical focus on Portugal, Spain, and Brazil, countries economically and culturally distinct, these boundaries emphasize their common belonging from the so-called margins of the art market.

Arte, cidadania e idadismo no envelhecimento

23 e 24 novembro 2023 - Centro Cultural de Belém, Lisboa

Esta conferência acontece no âmbito do projeto Causa Maior, integrado no programa PARTIS & Art For Change, que desde 2021 faz parte da vida da Companhia Maior (companhia com um elenco de intérpretes entre os 60 e 90 anos fundada em 2010). Partindo deste caso único no país, propomos uma reflexão coletiva e interdisciplinar para demarcar um terreno de investigação partilhado pela atividade cultural, a criação artística, as ciências sociais e as políticas públicas. Num programa de painéis, mesas redondas, oficinas e apresentações, são temas aglutinadores: as políticas públicas e práticas sociais para o envelhecimento ativo; projetos artísticos e educativos de referência; estética e criatividade na idade maior; e acesso e representação na cultura. Estas são questões fundamentais para lançar um debate urgente na esfera pública da cultura e da academia, com contributos para as políticas promotoras de uma cidadania ativa em domínios como a cultura a saúde, o trabalho ou a ação social.

Tendo como base a sua sólida formação em história da cultura e das ideias, a abordagem metodológica da arquitectura e do urbanismo no âmbito complexo da arte e da sua historicidade, atenta à sua operatividade no âmbito do património construído, permitiu que a influência do seu trabalho se fizesse sentir, literalmente, do Algarve ao Minho, mas também nos espaços com influência cultural portuguesa.

Transnational Collecting: Objects Crossing Borders, Objects

Transformed (Online Session at 112th CAA Annual Conference, 14-17

Feb 2024 Chicago)

What happens to objects when they cross borders and enter collections located beyond the cultures or nations in which they were produced? Objects don't have fixed meanings, and collectors are a vital source of redefinitions and revaluations of objects they collect.

Collectors translate and appropriate objects to their cultures, personal tastes, social milieux and ideologies.

Objects crossing borders challenge notions that works have autonomy or transcend time and place, eliciting important questions about collectors' roles in valuation and signification.

Walter Benjamin described collecting as "the most profound relation that one can have to things." In his view, collectors hide behind objects, glorify them, fetishize them and confer on objects "only a fancier's value, rather than use-value," turning objects into art (Charles Baudelaire, 168).

Design Research Society Conference 2024 (24-28 June, Boston)

We frame design ethics as an invitation to care and argue against reducing it to a methodology, framework, checklist, toolkit, or an afterthought. This broad framing acknowledges that 'ethics' can carry multiple meanings in different contexts (e.g. responsible, critical, democratic) and can be approached from various theoretical perspectives (e.g. historical, cultural, speculative). Consequently, we recognize the need for a nuanced and reflexive discussion on why, where and how ethical questions and dilemmas intersect with design research and practices. For this, we aim to look back with critical historical awareness, while also looking forward with cautious optimism.

We welcome both theoretical papers that unpack specific conceptual perspectives and practice-based explorations (e.g. in communities, organizations, policy-making).

Tuwaiq Sculpture Symposium (Riade, Arábia Saudita, 14-24 fevereiro 2024)

Artistas que tenham pelo menos cinco anos de experiência na área de escultura (com exposições em galerias e em espaços ao ar livre) são convidados a enviar propostas, até 31 de agosto, para o Tuwaiq Sculpture Symposium, a decorrer na cidade de Riade, na Arábia Saudita, entre os dias 14 e 24 de fevereiro de 2024, com curadoria de Marek Wolynski, especialista em "projetos de grande escala e parcerias intersetoriais".

O tema escolhido para esta edição — "Dimensões do Movimento" — incentiva à reflexão sobre "os avanços acelerados da sociedade moderna", motivando os escultores a criarem obras de arte ousadas e inspiradoras, que transcendam fronteiras. Como uma homenagem contemporânea ao Futurismo, o tema pretende captar "a vitalidade da transformação de Riade e o impulso ambicioso em direção à inovação e a novos horizontes", convidando os participantes a desenvolver trabalho que transmita "uma sensação de velocidade e poder" e que expanda "as percepções de espaço e tempo", incorporando "o espírito saudita de progresso e potencial ilimitado".
